Story-Telling Plates

What is YOUR story?

Brainstorm with a list or sketches

It can be:

- Imaginary, realistic, abstract, fantasy, “real-world”, dreams, fictional, etc.
- Landscapes, moonscapes, seascapes, etc.
- People, animals, objects, lettering, architecture, weather, plant life,
- “habitats”- mountains, hills, oceans, jungle, desert, etc.
- Vacations, important events, important people or moments, memories, about you...
- Don't copy a story exactly

Sketch out some ideas and an explanation about your story

You **MUST** show me a sketch before you start sculpting



Story-Telling Plates

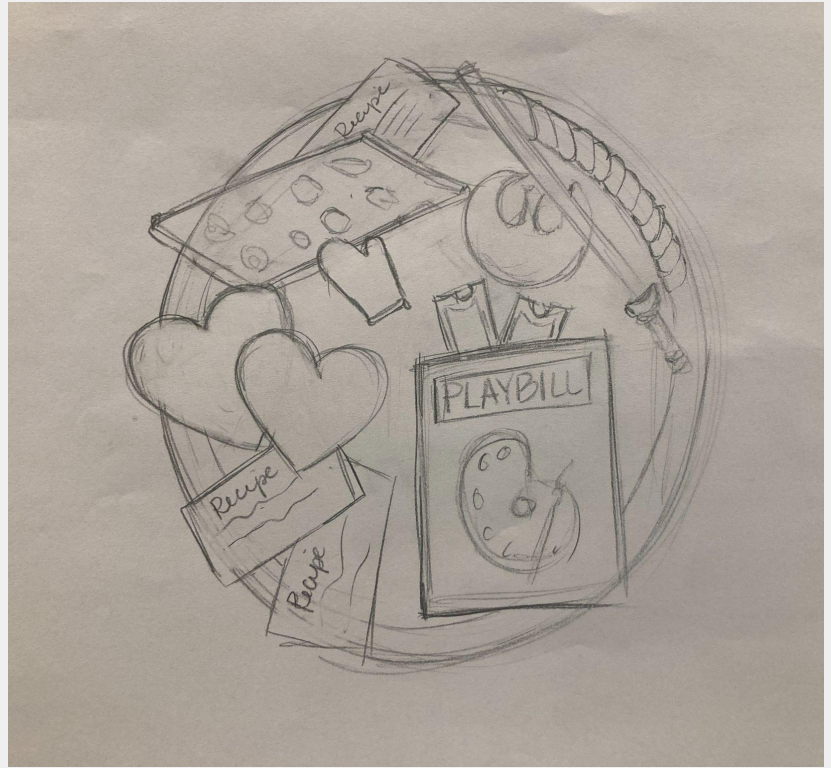
Your plate should have (requirements)

- **Relief** - pieces that are 3-dimensional and not flat
- Variety of **Textures**
- Tell a story or convey a story/theme to the viewer
- Have at least 5 “objects” or “pieces”

You will be receiving **2 grades** for this:

- 1 large grade- **100 point** project grade for sculpting/concept and creativity - Rubric will be posted
- 1 small grade - **20 point** grade for glazing (painting the color)
