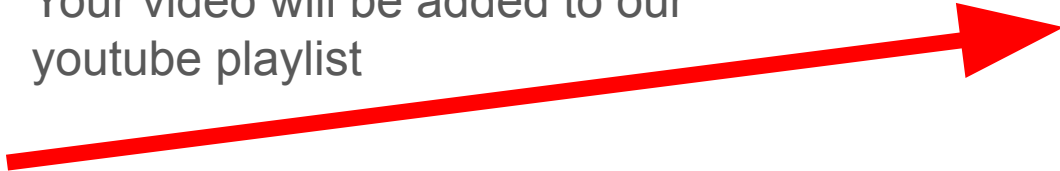

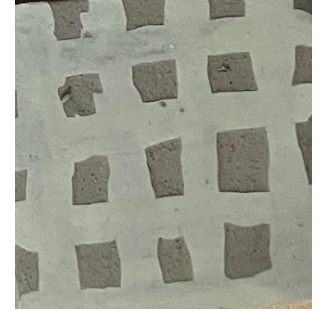
# Create tiles
