Relief Sculpture Plaque Inspired by Vintage Postcard Designs

Objective: to create a relief sculpture using a single slab of clay as a background with additional flat layers of text and imagery and/or designs added on top.

A **relief sculpture** is a one-sided, almost flat sculpture with the features built up from the background surface. Once complete, this piece should be able to be propped onto a small display easel or hung onto a wall.

Project Requirements:

- 1. The plaque should be between 7 x 9 and approximately 9 x 11 inches
- 2. The plaque may be vertical or horizontal
- 3. There must be one slab for the background surface of the piece
- 4. There must be some form of relief that has been created by adding clay appliqués or pieces of clay to build up the surface from the backing slab
- 5. There must be lettering
- 6. There are areas of carving into the clay; the carving may be on the added clay, the appliqués, or carved into the base slab
- 7. If the piece is to be hung on a wall, it must have two holes in both top corners
- 8. The sculpture must be painted with least 5 colors (using underglazes)




A Few Ideas inspired by Vintage Postcards:

You could base your design on a:

- A City or Town for example, Paris or New York (or Caldwell, NJ!)
- A Country
 Italy, Mexico, Japan, etc.
- A Landmark or Famous Place
 Niagara Falls, the Eiffel Tower, etc.

STEPS to BEGIN:

- 1. **DESIGN:** See the separate design handout
- 2. **ROLL THE SLAB** that will be the base of your project. Use a ruler to measure and cut the sides so they are the correct size and straight.
- 3. **SCORE and SLIP** to assemble **ALL** elements onto the base slab. Use a paintbrush to clean up and smooth all attached elements
- 4. **THINK ABOUT THE SURFACE MAKE IT SMOOTH** or **TEXTURED** depending on what is needed for your design; remember there should be areas of carving.



Rubric for the Design: 25 total points

- 0 to 6 points: lettering has been traced and added to the design; the font is specific and has been carefully observed or traced or transferred to the design
- 0 to 12 points: imagery, including at least 3 objects/details/landscape elements has been added to the design; multiple references have been used
- O to 7 points: color has been neatly added with color pencil (image should be fully colored; -5 points for color that is only indicated with words or labels)

Construction of the Relief Plaque

____/25 points Involvement in Project / Respect for the Classroom and Materials:

- Efficient use of class time; student is working on the project for the full class period (0 to 20 points)
- Complexity project is not too simplified / student is creating to the best of their ability
- Tools are used properly, cleaned, and returned to storage containers; brushes and palettes are washed and returned to their proper storage spaces; work surfaces are cleaned at the end of class
- Slab roller is used properly
- Project is stored carefully and does not dry out before finished (- 5 points if project needs to be restarted)

_/30 points Project-specific criteria:

- The plaque is at least 7 x 9 inches (-5 to points if plaque is smaller than 7 x 9 inches prior to firing)
- One slab has been used for the background surface of the piece
- There is some form of relief created by adding clay appliqués or pieces of clay to build up the surface from the backing slab (-10 points if there are no areas of relief / added slabs)
- Lettering / text has been added (-10 points if there is not lettering/text)
- There are areas of carving into the clay; on the added clay, the appliqués, or carved into the base slab (-5 points if there is not carving and -5 points if no additional texture is added)
- There are two holes in both top corners, if needed

_/20 points Craftsmanship and Application of Design Elements

- The relief is carefully crafted, applied to the background slab, the design and/or text and imagery is carefully carved and sculpted
- The project is not cracked with chipped, loose areas (0 to 5 points)
- Tool-marks and fingerprints are removed before the project is fired in the kiln (0 to 5 points)
- Areas of scoring do not show along joined edges (0 to 5 points)
- Any areas of carving have been cleaned up and rough clay has been removed (0 to 5 points)

/10 points Creative Design

- Interesting and/or unique textures and designs
- Successful solution to the assignment
- Effective use of text / lettering

Underglaze and Glazing 30 total points

- Sculpture is painted with least 5 color of underglazes (0 to 5 points)
- The underglaze is carefully painted and opaque; no unintentionally thin areas of color (0 to 15 points)
- Effective selection of colors appropriate to the design and the colors work together (0 to 10 points)
